4. President's Report

Hall of Fame Society – Discussion: Been trying to reinstate the charitable status, rules have changed since first applied. Since then some criteria have changed. They voluntarily revoked their charity status, so we put in an application to CRA to try and get it back. We've talked to lawyers at Fulton and Co. and he said he would charge us up to \$1,500 to get paperwork together. There is no guarantee we would get



- charity status back. Benefits would be: being able to host 50/50 draws, give away scholarship and bursaries to youth, and providing taxable receipts for donations.

- City of Kamloops Service Agreement we have been told that we are to meet with Finance Committee 6min to present and 9min for questions. Review core services, programs, and initiatives. How does the funding from the City of Kamloops better the community. If we weren't offering them, they City would be, so we need to show why it's a worthwhile investment from the City. There won't be a ton of scrutiny for KSC, some other groups have much longer presentations and will be grilled more, need to justify our existence to the committee. - Mini Golf: Parks has done some work on the course, but the current state of the landscaping is all the work that will happen. Turf will not be replaced. If people bring their own clubs then they play for free. They are asking KSC to rent out clubs only, no fee to play. City also asked if KSC wants to rent out discs. KSC would have to purchase clubs, balls, and scorecards. At this current time there isn't an appetite from the KSC board to take on this project.
- Legacy Games Recap: Rugbyfest, Ultimate, Pickleball. Had planned on a more robust event but plans with TK and COK didn't come to fruition. We had 775 participants in the LPG. There was an issue with the permit process with the City, none of our field bookings were moved over to new management system. There is still interest to move rugby over to McArthur Island, it would be a central spot for First Aid, all age categories, and hosting a social event.
